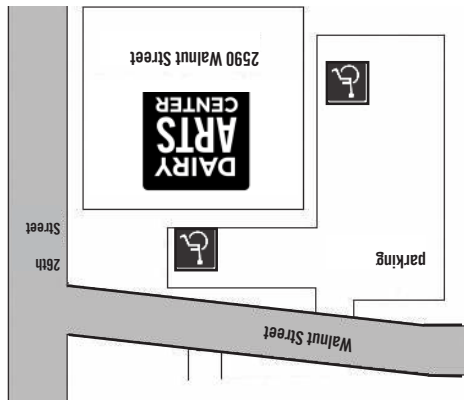
LOVING HIGHSMITH

This light comedy touches on sensitive issues with great ease. The Castillons seem to be the perfect family. That is until Annie, the mother, finds a positive pregnancy test in the bathroom. Is it Juliette's, her son's girlfriend? Poupri's, her teenage daughter? Another woman in her husband's life? Does her other son actually have girlfriends? SCRAP

SCRAP is a love letter to the things we use in our daily lives. Using soaring aerials to capture the size and scope of often surreal landscapes, this cinematic doc tells the story of people who have deep connections to objects that have reached their 'end of life'. FRIDAY NIGHT WEIRD

PIGGY - November 4

A teenager whose excess weight makes her the target of incessant bullying, Sara flees a clique of capricious girls who torment her at the town pool, only to stumble upon them being brutally kidnapped by a stranger, who drives off with them in his van. When the police begin asking questions,

Sara keeps quiet. Intrigued by the stranger -- an interest that's mutual. (Carlotia Pereda, 2022, Spain, 1:30, NR)

VOYAGE OF THE ROCK ALIENS

November 11 - Starring the legendary actress and singer Pia Zadora (Butterfly, Hairspray) in what might be the wildest and wackiest role of her career, James Fargo's (Every Which Way But Loose) VOYAGE OF THE ROCK ALIENS is a nearly unclassifiable smorgasbord made up of one part rock musical, one part sci-fi insanity, and one part 50s kitsch through an 80s glam lens. TALES FROM THE GIMLI HOSPITAL

November 18 - Maddin's highly acclaimed first feature, released in 1988, is now regarded as one of the true cult hits on the midnight movie circuit. Tales From The Gimli Hospital Redux is a dream-like, elliptical film which explores the jealousy and madness instilled in two men who share a hospital room "in a Gimli we no longer know." ALL JACKED UP AND FULL OF WORMS

November 25 - Roscoe, a janitor for a scuzzy love motel, whose girlfriend has brought another man home for strange rituals, drifts through life until he discovers a hidden stash of powerful hallucinogenic worms. (Alex Phillips, 2022, USA, 1:12, NR)

SOMETHING IN THE DIRT

December 2 - When neighbors John and Levi witness supernatural events in their Los Angeles apartment building, they realize documenting the paranormal could inject some fame and fortune into their wasted lives. An ever-deeper, darker rabbit hole, their friendship frays as they uncover the dangers of the phenomena, the city and each other. (Justin Benson & Aaron Moorhead, 2022, USA, 1:55, R)
